



RED BULL AIR RACE - INDIANAPOLIS - 06 & 07 OCTOBER

Nicolas Ivanoff and Team Hamilton race at Indianapolis Motor Speedway! This weekend, the french pilot will fly at an iconic racetrack in the American heartland for the third consecutive year.

Coming off his best finish of 2018 at Wiener Neustadt, Austria less than three weeks ago, the Team Hamilton pilot is also fired up to aim for a finish in the Final 4 not only at Indianapolis, but also in November's season finale at Texas Motor Speedway, where he was the race winner in 2014. "Over the years, we have had some of our best results at auto-racing tracks, so we're very happy to close the season at two speedways, and it's great to start this American leg at a location with so much history. We're looking forward to taking off."



Dating to 1909, the oval at Indianapolis was the world's first speedway, and over the past century motorsport history has been made at "The Brickyard" again and again. Ivanoff thoroughly enjoys the atmosphere, from his view of a rolling green infield dotted with trees to the traditional parade where pilots ride in front of the grandstands in classic American convertibles before the racing begins.
