











Second Red Bull Air Race of the 2019 season 15 & 16 June in Russia - Kazan

The Red Bull Air Race season opener in Abu Dhabi was a rollercoaster for French fans. Corsican pilot Nicolas Ivanoff battled two former World Champions head-to-head to earn a place in the Final 4, only to find that his engine would not start for that critical round. Nonetheless, he comes into the second stop at Kazan, Russia this weekend in fourth place overall, just three points off a potential position on the World Championship podium.

"After so many problems during the past two seasons, I have to say that the result in Abu Dhabi was super good, and with fourth place, the engine issue was not very important. The progress we made was the result of the whole team working together, and it shows that we are on the path to improving our level. We have to maintain this to have a good last season in the sport this year! Abou Dhabi is always earlier in the season and the break was enough important before the return of the competition. The plan for this race is the same as for the last few races, because the Abu Dhabi result confirmed that we are moving in the right direction. We want to keep the same spirit in the team, and above all to enjoy this last race in Russia, the country of my grandfather!"
